PhD students in finance are invited to submit their application for two EFA Doctoral Events to be held at IESE Business School in Barcelona, Spain, August 24, 2022. These two pre-conference events designed for doctoral students run in parallel and take place just prior to the official start of the 49<sup>th</sup> EFA Annual Meeting in Barcelona (August 24-27, 2022). Dual submission to the Annual Meeting and Doctoral Tutorial or Workshop is allowed – but as the tutorial and workshop run at the same time, you cannot apply to both. There is no fee to submit and EFA membership not required. We are planning to hold the EFA 2022 conference in real life. Deadline for submission for both doctoral events is March 15, 2022 at 1pm (13:00) Central European Time (CET).

#### DOCTORAL TUTORIAL

The EFA Doctoral Tutorial (EFA-DT) is an annual EFA Doctoral Event intended for Finance students who are nearing completion of their PhD and about to enter the job market. It provides students with an excellent opportunity to present their paper and receive detailed feedback from a distinguished faculty. The current format allows the EFA-DT co-chairs to select up to eight PhD student papers for presentation. Accepted students receive a stipend of EUR 1,000 to help cover registration and travel expenses.

The workshop will focus for a second year on FinTech: digital currency and blockchains, which has become one of the fastest growing research areas in Finance. We will examine research into the architecture of distributed ledgers, decentralized consensus protocols, and smart contracts, as well as the governance issues connected to them. Uses of cryptocurrency in payments, entrepreneurial finance (ICOs), remittances, and capital market clearing and settlement will be explored. Additional sessions will consider research into the performance of digital assets as investments and the emergence of stablecoins as potential rivals to sovereign fiat currencies, among other topics. This EFA-DW will highlight the most important research published to date on these topics and look closely at emerging regulation and FinTech data sources.
