

## **JOINING INSTRUCTIONS**

### **By car or train**

#### Driving to Genoa:

A7 highway: from Milan-Genoa (toll).

A10 highway: Ventimiglia-Genoa (toll).

A12 highway: Rome-Genoa (toll).

#### Arrival at Genoa train station:

The Genova Piazza Principe train station is located in the city center.

From the station you can walk to the Department of Economics and Business Studies (approx.. 10 minutes) or reach all the suggested accommodations within 15 minutes.

You can also take any taxi (5 minutes).

### **Flights**

#### GENOA AIRPORT CRISTOFORO COLOMBO (GOA)

This is a small regional airport serving inter-European flights. It is only a 15-minute taxi ride from the Department of Economics and Business Studies, University of Genoa.

#### MILAN MALPENSA (MXP) INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

A large international airport serving inter-European and intercontinental flights.

Train: There is a train station inside the airport. It takes about 3 hours to get from the airport to Milan Central Station and then Genova Piazza Principe station, which is close to the Department of Economics and Business Studies and to all the suggested accommodations (walking distance, approximately 15 minutes).

Cost: 70 euros round trip (approximately).

## MILAN LINATE (LIN) AIRPORT

A regional airport serving inter-European flights.

Train: A shuttle will bring you to Milan central station, where you can take a train to Genova Piazza Principe station, which is close to the Department of Economics and Business Studies and to all the suggested accommodations (walking distance, approximately 15 minutes).

## BERGAMO ORIO AL SERIO (BGY) AIRPORT

A regional airport serving inter-European low-cost flights.

Train: A bus will bring you to Milan central station, where you can take a train to Genova Piazza Principe station, which is close to the Department of Economics and Business Studies and to all the suggested accommodations (walking distance, approximately 15 minutes).

Bus tickets to Milan central station can be booked at [Autostradale | Choose your Destination](https://www.autostradale.it).

Alternatively, you can take a bus to the Bergamo train station and then a train to Milan central station.

Cost: 60 euros round trip (approximately).

## PISA (PSA) AIRPORT

A regional airport serving inter-European flights.

Train: A shuttle will bring you to Pisa central station, where you can take a train to Genova Piazza Principe station, which is close to the Department of Economics and Business Studies and to all the suggested accommodations (walking distance, approximately 15 minutes). It takes about 2 hours to get from Pisa central station to Genova Piazza Principe.

Cost: 60 euros round trip (approximately).

## NICE (NCE) AIRPORT

A regional airport serving inter-European flights.

Train: The tram line 2 “Port Lympia” provides a direct connection to the Nice Ville Station, where you can take a train to Genova Piazza Principe station, which is close to the Department of Economics and Business Studies and to all the suggested accommodations (walking distance, approximately 15 minutes). It takes about 3 hours and a half to get from Nice Ville station to Genova Piazza Principe.
