Bernd Frick is Professor of Organizational and Media Economics in the Faculty of Management and Economics (since July 2007) and Vice President of the University of Paderborn with the responsibility for strategy, finance, and international relations (since January 2008). Moreover, he is Director of Volkswagen's Institute of Labour and Personnel Management at MobileLife Campus in Wolfsburg (since March 2011).

He studied sociology, economics and political science at the University of Trier and at Clark University, Worcester, MA. He received both, his Ph.D. and his "Habilitation" in Business Administration at the University of Trier (the former with a dissertation in labour economics in 1990 and the latter with a comparative study in industrial relations in 1996).

Before joining the Faculty of Management and Economics at the University of Paderborn he held the Chair in Personnel and Organizational Economics at the University of Greifswald (1995-2001) and the Reinhard Mohn-Chair in Organizational Economics and Leadership at Witten/Herdecke University (2001-2007). Moreover, he refused offers from the London School of Economics and Political Science, the University of Vienna, Zeppelin University in Friedrichshafen and the Max-Planck-Institute for Human Development in Berlin.

He has published about 50 refereed papers in peer-reviewed journals like *Applied Economics*, *British Journal of Industrial Relations*, *Contemporary Economic Policy*, *European Journal of Sport Management*, *European Journal of Operational Research*, *Industrial and Labor Relations Review*, *Industrial Relations*, *International Journal of Human Resource Management*, *Journal of Economic Issues*, *Journal of Sports Economics*, *Kyklos*, *Labour*, *Managerial and Decision Economics*, *Oxford Review of Economic Policy*, *Scandinavian Journal of Economics* and *Scottish Journal of Political Economy*.

When younger, he was a mediocre football player and a competitive marathon runner (although somewhat slower today, he continues to be an ambitious runner).
